## **Aug 1 - Fairbanks**

Today your great Alaska Adventure starts by flying to Fairbanks, where you'll check into our Fairbanks hotel.

## **Aug 2 - Riverboat Discovery**

A perfect way to immerse yourself in native culture is on a sternwheeler cruise aboard the Riverboat *Discovery*. Lunch is included today at the Riverboat Landing. Overnight in Fairbanks. *Optional Activities tonight: Salmon Bake and/or Palace Theatre excursion.*

## **Aug 3 - Denali National Park**

Board the luxury domed railcar, the McKinley Explorer, for a great sightseeing ride to Denali. Your afternoon is free to relax and enjoy Denali National Park your way. *Optional Activity - a 4-hour Natural History tour of Denali National Park, or you can opt for a longer Tundra Wilderness tour that gives you the best opportunity to see bears, caribou and other wildlife.*

## **Aug 4 - South to Anchorage**

Continue your scenic journey via the McKinley Explorer through miles of stunning wilderness. Keep a sharp eye out for picturesque Hurricane Gulch, Wasilla, and the occasional moose! Overnight in Anchorage.

## **Aug 5 - Anchorage to Seward**

### **Ship departs at 8pm**

Step aboard your motorcoach for a breathtaking drive - watch for dall sheep, beluga whales and especially moose. In Seward, on the shore of Resurrection Bay, board Holland America's beautiful **Statendam** for lunch, then shop in town or visit Alaska Sealife Center before setting sail this evening. All meals while on board the ship are included.

## **Aug 6 - Cruising Prince William Sound**

Cruise the pristine waters of Prince William Sound. Be on the lookout for sea otters, seals, porpoises, sea lions, and whales. More than 200 species of birds inhabit the sound including the most commonly sighted Bald Eagle.

## **Aug 7 - Cruising Glacier Bay National Park**

Today, enjoy an insightful commentary from an on-board U.S. park ranger/naturalist as spellbinding Glacier Bay sights unfold, from mighty icebergs to breathtaking crystalline fjords. Bring your camera and binoculars.

## **Aug 8 - Haines (6:30 AM - 9:00 PM)**

Haines is known as "The Valley of the Eagles", so you might enjoy a visit to the fascinating bald eagle preserve today. Or take a stroll around the town enjoying a sampling of Alaska's history, scenic beauty, arts and culture.

*Optional Activity - Take a fast ferry over to charming Skagway, gateway to the Yukon's 1896 Klondike Gold Rush, to see the restored storefronts and saloons.*

## **Aug 9 - Juneau (8:00 AM - 6:00 PM)**

Sightseeing opportunities abound in and around Alaska's capital city. You may explore the city at leisure or choose an optional shore excursion. Take a glacier dog sled adventure, or combine a visit to Glacier Gardens with a tour to Mendenhall Glacier, or perhaps you'd like to climb aboard the Mt. Roberts Tramway for a ride to the top. It's a great spot to shoot a souvenir photo of our ship in port. History buffs will enjoy browsing the Alaska State Museum. Be sure to allow time for a little shopping and a photo stop at the famous Red Dog Saloon in the heart of downtown Juneau.

## **Aug 10 - Ketchikan (11:00 AM - 7:00 PM)**

Built out over the water and climbing weathered stairways, Ketchikan clings to the shores of Tongass Narrows and drapes the mountains with a cheerful air. Besides the main attractions - Creek Street, the Tongass Historical Museum, Totem Bight State Park and Saxman Village - you might be interested in an optional flightseeing trip to breathtaking Misty Fjords National Monument. These deep water fjords, formed by retreating glaciers, left granite cliffs towering thousands of feet above the sea and countless waterfalls cascading into placid waters. Or join Sue for an optional visit to Totem Heritage Center and Deer Mountain Hatchery.

## **Aug 11 - Scenic Cruising Inside Passage**

Enjoy your last full day of cruising as our ship weaves through protected waters filled with marine life, past shores lined with lush green rainforests and the occasional small villages accessible only by water. The scenic Southeast Alaska and British Columbia coastline offers many great photo opportunities.

## **Aug 12 - Arrive Canada Place / Disembark Cruise in Vancouver**

Once our ship clears customs in Vancouver, we'll disembark and transfer to the airport for our flight home. What memories you'll be able to share with family and friends!

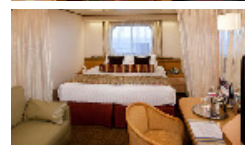

### PAYMENTS

A non-refundable deposit of \$750.00 per person (check or cash only) is due at time of booking.

A second non-refundable deposit of \$750.00 per person (check or cash only) is due by February 22, 2012.

Final payment is due on or before May 3, 2012, and can be by check, cash, or credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover). All monies paid are non-refundable.

### TRIP CANCELLATION & INTERRUPTION INSURANCE

Trip Cancellation & Interruption Insurance is NOT included in the cost of this package. We highly recommend purchasing this insurance since all payments are non-refundable. As we will be entering Canada, you will need a passport, valid six (6) months past your return date of Aug 12, 2012.
