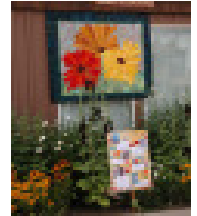

# Sisters 37th Annual Quilt Show

**Day 1, Tue, 7/10 KANSAS CITY TO PORTLAND** We'll travel via 2 vehicles to Kansas City for our mid-afternoon flight to Portland. After changing planes in Denver and arriving Portland around 7 PM, we'll pick up our 15-passenger van and head to our home for the next 3 nights, the Phoenix Inn Suites in Tigard, a suburb of Portland. Dinner tonight is on our own.

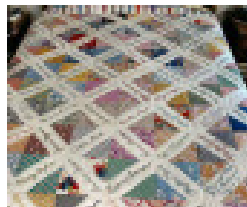
**Day 2, Wed, 7/11 PORTLAND AREA** After breakfast we'll begin the our amazing quilt-lovers' adventure. Today we'll traverse the great city of Portland to visit shops that are filled with fabric, needlework, and quilt supplies! In our quest to bring you the best that Portland



has to offer, we'll shop our way through buildings the size of a small aircraft hangar, and as cozy as a country store. We'll also visit the fabulous International Rose Test Gardens, wandering through four fragrant acres that make up this Elizabethan-style garden and which give

Portland the apropos nickname "City of Roses." Dinner tonight will be at the popular Gustav's German Pub & Grill in Tigard. (B,D)

**Day 3, Thur, 7/12 COASTAL OREGON** Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. Today we'll travel to the Oregon coast to enjoy two charming seaside communities ~ Cannon Beach and Tillamook. A mecca for artisans, Cannon Beach is lined with shops and galleries that showcase one-of-a-kind handcrafted items. We'll definitely visit Center Diamond Fabrics, a local quilt shop specializing in gorgeous 100% cotton fabrics. Today we'll also enjoy a delicious, classic High Tea at La Tea Da, followed by a visit to the Latimer Quilt & Textile Center for a very special repository tour. Then have your cameras ready as we follow the Tillamook County Quilt Trail before returning to Portland. Dinner tonight is on your own at Washington Square. (B,L)



**Day 4, Fri, 7/13 PORTLAND TO BEND.** Today we depart the Portland area and travel south, passing verdant valleys and rolling hills on our way to Salem, capital of Oregon. Our visit here is like a step back in time. Unique shops, antique emporiums, and department stores form part of the charm of this "city for walking."

**Day 4, Fri, 7/13 (continued)** Nestled among the storefronts is a quilters fantasyland, a shop filled with all kinds of fabrics, notions, trims, books, and the most whimsical displays. Lunch is included at Word of Mouth. Our next stop is another memorable town, this one nestled at the foot of the Cascade Mountains. Looking more like the set for a cowboy movie than a real town, Sisters truly is a place right out of the old West!

Its old-fashioned main street is lined with frontier stores stocked with all kinds of goodies! Tomorrow these buildings will be covered with quilts, hung every which way, to celebrate the annual Sisters Quilt Show. Today, though, before the crowds arrive, we can do a little pre-show shopping, especially at the popular Stitchin' Post quilt shop. Later we'll join in the fun at one of the show's most popular events—a picnic dinner in the park. Not only do they display some of the quilts made by some of the locals and employees of the Stitchin' Post, but they also have a featured speaker (identify of same TBA early next year). Always a truly enjoyable event. Afterward we'll be ready to check into The Shilo Inn & Suites in Bend, Oregon for a 2-night stay. (B,L,D)



**Day 5, Sat, 7/14 SISTERS OUTDOOR QUILT SHOW** Show Time! It's Quilt Show time in Sisters, and it's just a short drive from Bend to this festive celebration. Quilts appear everywhere...hung on the sides of buildings, over balconies, in windows, draped over fences and posts...this is the **LARGEST OUTDOOR QUILT SHOW IN THE WORLD!!** With the ambiance of an old-fashioned country fair, the streets fill with friendly folks, both quilters and non-quilters, who've come to celebrate this glorious day. And for the real "Quilt-aholics", you'll have a full day to shop-hop. This evening our farewell dinner will be at the Pine Tavern Restaurant in Bend. (B,D)

**Day 6, Sun, 7/15 TO PORTLAND AND HOME.** We'll depart EARLY this morning, with a stop for the "best breakfast in town" at Madras (at the Black Bear Diner) before continuing our journey north to the Historic Columbia River Gorge Highway. Driving west along this highway, we'll make a quick stop to view beautiful Multnomah Falls cascading over the walls of the Gorge. Then it's straight to the Portland airport in time to drop off our vehicle and board our late-afternoon flight. With a quick change of planes, we'll arrive back in Kansas City at 9:44 PM. (B)
